

Minutes of the ESSZ Swim Committee Meeting-Auburn, AL*Saturday, July 24, 2004*

1. Minutes were approved from spring meeting in Nashville.
2. No membership report.
3. No financial report.
4. Aaron Reeves reported that there are still 10 outstanding clubs from previous sectionals that have not paid their fines. All clubs that were entered this year are in good standing. Please send fines and proofs to:

5. No travel report except that Trials swimmers will get 2 shares and National swimmers will get 1 share after all monies are in. It will be approximately \$200 and \$100. One must have attended either one of the Sectional meets this year to get the reimbursement.
6. Time standards and meet formats will stay the same for next year.
7. No one volunteered to be Sectional chairperson, (TJ Liston will continue for the time being.)
8. MAC will host spring senior sectionals at the Hendersonville pool March 10-13 (assuming Nationals are March 29-April 2).
No one volunteered to host spring AG sectionals. Dynamo has agreed to host the AG Meet.
Georgia Tech (and Swim Atlanta) will host next summer's Sectionals. It will be July 14-17 assuming Nationals are the first weekend in August.
9. It was voted to not accept hytec for proof of times. However, it was voted to accept a copy of the star system for proof.
10. Dave Gibson expressed concern that there will be no Grand Prix meets in the East or Southeast next summer. All meets are in the west, including Nationals. It makes it very difficult and expensive for clubs to travel. Plus no local exposure. He recommended that we email USA Swimming and let them aware that we are all concerned about this.
